Field Excursion "Environmental degradation and rehabilitation in South Thailand"

December 21 Dec. (Tue) afternoon: Move from Hat Yai to Satun. Stay at Satun city.
December 22 (Wed): Visit Mangrove Seed Production Center and mangrove forest, and a charcoal kiln site along the Andaman Sea coast; Traveling northeastward and visit Lake Songkla, Coastal erosion site, Flood tide hazard site, and Shrimp farming along the Thailand Bay coast. Stay at Nakhon Si Thammarat.
December 23 (Thu): Visit Phipun landslide disaster basin and move to Surat Thani. Stay at Surat Thani.
December 24 (Fri): Short concluding meeting and closing at the hotel. (Move to Surat Thani airport)
Partial modification is possible according to weather and road conditions.

List the authors with the given name capitalizing the first letter and the family name capitalizing all letters. Show the affiliation, the address, and the E-mail address in 9 point type.
